- **Absolutely NO dogs allowed on property**

- Telephone entries will NOT be accepted

- Correct headgear required.
- 50 rides is the show limit. Less than 25 rides may cancel the show.
- Boots and Bandages are allowed
- **Horse Council Membership is mandatory. No exceptions.**
- **Enclose a photocopy of current HCBC membership card for both the rider and owner.**
- You may only ride a maximum of four tests on the same horse
- All tests will be held in the 20 x 60 arena
- **Please return a signed & witnessed Liability Release (attached) with entry:** Juniors, please have a parent or guardian sign. **No signed Consent - No competition number.**
- **Entries Close:** The Wednesday before the show date or when 50 rides have been received, whichever comes first.

Ride Times: Will be emailed the Friday before the show. Please ensure your email address is legible.

Tests:

- EC Tests will be used for English
- **WDAA tests will be used for Western (new this year)**
- Class 23 Test of Choice – you are welcome to ride any test. Please provide a copy if it is not and EC or HCBC test.
- Class 24 – 10 minutes in show arena no judge

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Show Information

- hand sanitizer located at north and south entrances and north entrance of indoor.
- the boarder's alleys will be off limits as will the breezeway along the indoor arena.
- entrance to washroom is at the south end of the facility.

The indoor arena will be open for warm up and cool down.

Where can I lunge my horse?

There is a lunging arena on site that is available first come first serve.
